NASA satellites used to predict zebra migrations

One of the world's longest migrations of zebras occurs in the African nation of Botswana, about a 360 mile round trip! But predicting when and where zebras will move has not been possible until now.

Using NASA rain and vegetation data, researchers can track when and where arid lands begin to green, and now for the first time anticipate if zebras will make the trek or, if the animals find poor conditions en route, understand why they will turn back.

Intermediate Guide to ArcGIS

The [Intermediate Guide to ArcGIS](#) training course is designed to follow on from the GIS247 Beginners Guide to ArcGIS and provides the opportunity for users to enhance their skills to an intermediate level.



It is also suitable for users who are already using ArcGIS (ArcMap, ArcToolbox and ArcCatalog) periodically, but want to develop their knowledge further.

This Intermediate course builds upon core user skills obtained from the Beginners course by introducing the more complex functions of 'ArcGIS for Desktop' in relation to adding, querying, displaying and analysing data. Additional functions such as creating and building Geodatabases, joining/relating information based on attributes, analysis by location features and creating buffers are considered.

The course is structured as a combination of presentations and hands-on exercises over 9 sections. GIS247 provides the Intermediate Guide to ArcGIS training courses for all previous versions of ArcGIS 9 and 10, with the most recent training courses developed incorporating the latest changes introduced at version 10.2.

Question of the Month: What is a GIS247 Administrator?

Every organisation with a licence to GIS247 appoints a person to be in charge of their training licence. This GIS247 administrator can create accounts for individuals from their organisation giving them unlimited access to the training. They can also delete accounts, re-set passwords, restrict access to certain courses, create groups to organise users and they can also review the progress that each individual has made with their training.

Can there be more than one Administrator?

Yes - We recommend that a second person has administrator capabilities, just in case the main administrator is away and a user needs something like a password re-setting. Individual users can *always* contact GIS247 directly if they need to.

GIS247 Website Changes

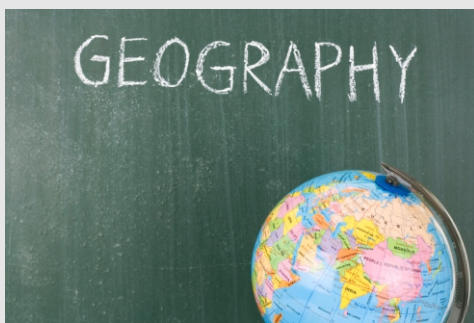
Not all the changes and improvements to the GIS247 website are obvious at first. Some of the improvements are under functions
